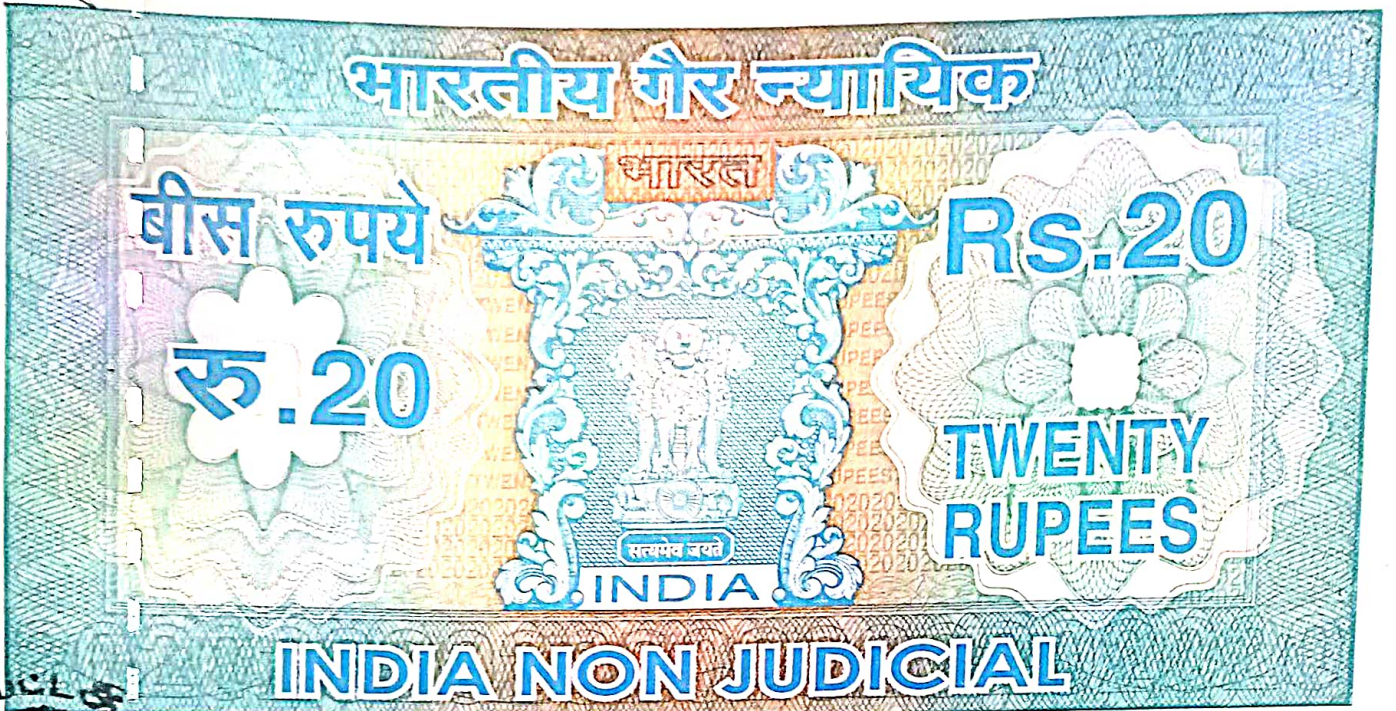

**M/s.ROTARY CLUB OF CHENNAI NORTH CHARITABLE TRUST** represented by its Chairman of Trust **Mr.SURESH KRISHN**, having its office at 24C, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue, Indira Nagar, Adyar, Chennai – 600 020, hereinafter referred to as the **Party of the Second Part** which term shall include its successors and permitted assigns of the Other Part.

WHEREAS the Party of the Second Part approached the Party of the First Part for accommodation for its manufacturing units for the production and supplying of napkin and its related products.

WHEREAS the Party of the First Part has agreed to provide accommodation in their premises to the Party of the Second Part, for manufacturing units for the production of Napkin and its related products. .

The Parties have decided to reduce the terms and conditions mutually agreed upon into writing through these presents.

NOW THESE PRESENTS WITNESSETH AND THE PARTIES HEREBY AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Party of the First Part agreed to provide suitable accommodation in their premises to the Party of the Second Part for manufacturing units for the production of Napkin and its related products for a period of 6 (six) years which starts from 01.07.2019.
2. The Party of the Second Part shall establish manufacturing unit for the production of Napkin, at its own expenses.
3. The Party of the Second Part is desirous of manufacturing and supplying part of their own Napkin products to the students in various Government schools who are under poverty line.
4. Both the parties agreed that, to meet the cost of manufacturing products, machines and its maintenance, the Party of the Second Part shall sell its own manufacturing Napkin products to the students of DR.MGR-JANAKI COLLEGE OF ARTS AND SCIENCE FOR WOMEN and outside also, at the affordable price.
5. Since the main object of the Party of the Second Part is the endowment, the Party of the First Part shall provide its own space of building for the said manufacturing unit at the free of cost including EB charges and water charges consumed by the Party of the Second Part.
6. The Party of the Second Part is permitted by the Party of the First Part to have a name board which can be fixed at the suitable place at the outside of the said manufacturing unit.
7. All municipal taxes, rates and other levies in respect of the said premises would be paid by the Party of the First Part.
8. All internal and external repairs for the said accommodation shall be carried out by the Party of the First Part at its cost.

## Memorandum of Understanding

This memorandum of understanding is made and entered into on the **1<sup>st</sup> of August, 2019** between Confederation of Indian Industry, Young Indians (hereinafter referred as CII-Yi) and Dr. MGR-Janaki College of Arts and Science for Women (hereinafter referred to as MJC).

### Whereas

**MJC** is an educational institution which focuses primarily on promotion of Arts & Science and women's education in Chennai was founded by Dr.Latha Rajendran in the year 1996 as a tribute to Late Bharat Ratna Dr. M.G. Ramachandran, former Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu & his beloved wife Mrs.V.N,Janaki. MJC is affiliated to the University of Madras.

### And Whereas

Confederation of Indian Industry (CII) is a Society registered under Society Registration Act having its office at Mantosh Sondhi Centre, 23 Institutional Area, Lodi Road, New Delhi 110003. Young Indians (Yi) is an initiative and integral part of the CII formed with an objective of creating a platform for Young Indian's to realize the dream of a developed nation. It has over 2700 direct members in 42 city chapters, and indirect membership of 19000 through its Yuva. "To become the Voice of Young Indian's Globally" being the vision of Yi, it reaches out to the global Indians wherever they are to make them an integral part of the Indian Growth Story.

### And Whereas

The CII-Yi Yuva platform is one of the most active focus areas within Young Indians by which Yi members engage students from across the country in various initiatives that the students conceptualize, plan and execute. The objective is to create a bridge, a platform for the students to work in cross functional teams with a broad objective of enhancing their leadership skills and giving back to the nation. In the process, the students work in leadership roles while operationalizing projects that are based on self-development, skill building, community service and nation building.

It is hereby mutually agreed to by both parties as follows

In tune with the Yuva vision to influence inspire and motivate millions of students across the country, Yi will work with **MJC** by forming a Yi Yuva.



Through the CII-Yi Yuva, Yi intends to provide an opportunity to start thinking and work for India, Sowing the seeds of thinking about India and its growth at schools and colleges, an invaluable motivation for young minds to see how other young achievers are making a difference, bridging potential with achievement, a unique networking opportunity with peers across the country, developing leaders for tomorrow, an experience on leadership and team building and an opportunity to volunteer / participate in Yi events at the chapter and national level.

The role of the institution would be to enroll a minimum of 250 students at the beginning of the year and increase the same substantially through the years that follow; that their contact details will be given on the day of their sign-up ; that it undertakes to follow the charter (attached), that it will depute a faculty/ teacher coordinator for the Yi Yuva whose role has been defined in the charter, that the students will be given the motivation and opportunities to engage in activities and initiatives that they conceptualize, that these

students are to make reports regularly on their activities to the Yi Executive Member (also mentioned in the annexure) and that the students will be allowed to participate in the Yi National & Chapter events in other cities like the summit (finer details to be worked in coherence with the institution's policies)

The role of Yi will be to nominate a member from within its membership (called as Yuva Chair) who will be a mentor to the Yuva.

### **Funding**

Unless otherwise specifically agreed to in writing by the Parties, each Party will bear on their own the respective costs of carrying out the obligations under this MOU. In the event of any consequential financial obligations arising out of any initiative of the parties under this MoU, the parties would take appropriate decision by mutual consultation and consent through the separate documents(s) on a case to case basis. Taxes if any will be charged extra and withholding tax if any will be deducted by respective party on any financial transaction as per applicable laws

### **Termination**

Yi may terminate this MoU forthwith in the event of any breach of the terms mentioned in this MoU or in the attachments. This termination will be on mutual basis by either party giving the other a prior written notice of one month in writing.

Each party will be entitled to receive / obligated to pay pro-rata funds to the other party for the activities mentioned under the MOU upto the date of termination if any agreed upon

### **Miscellaneous**

The partners or their representatives or the volunteers will not project or represent in any manner CII because this is a voluntary organization and has nothing to do with the other activities of the CII and its associates. The Memorandum either directly or indirectly will not confer any right on any partner or volunteer to claim any amount from CII either suffered on account of any accident or loss caused because of any activity or on any account."

Both parties hereby agree that the terms and conditions for the above individual activities shall be mutually agreed and reviewed and updated from time to time.

This Agreement will be in force for an initial period of three year and may be extended for further periods before the expiry of this Agreement.

Irrespective of the period of the agreement validity the subscription fee (INR 100 + GST) shall be paid once a year, every year till the expiry of Yuva Subscription, towards CII-Yi.

This agreement shall become effective from today, the 1<sup>st</sup> of August, 2019 upon signing of this agreement.




