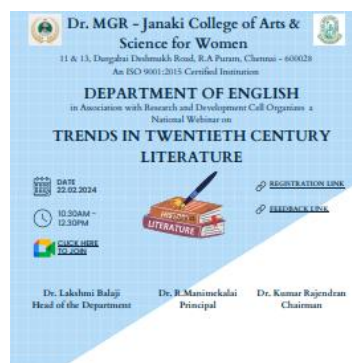

On Day 3, Ms. Anubha George delivered a lecture on "Contemporary Trends in Social Media," exploring the profound impact of various popular media worldwide.

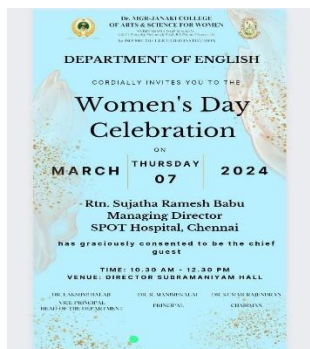

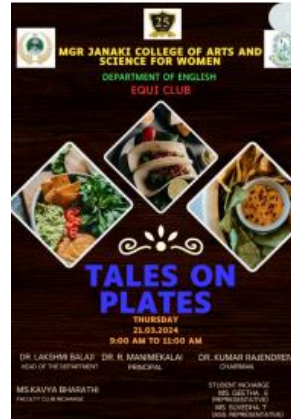
CLUB ACTIVITIES
